

CSA WINTER FUNDRAISER - FINAL WEEK!

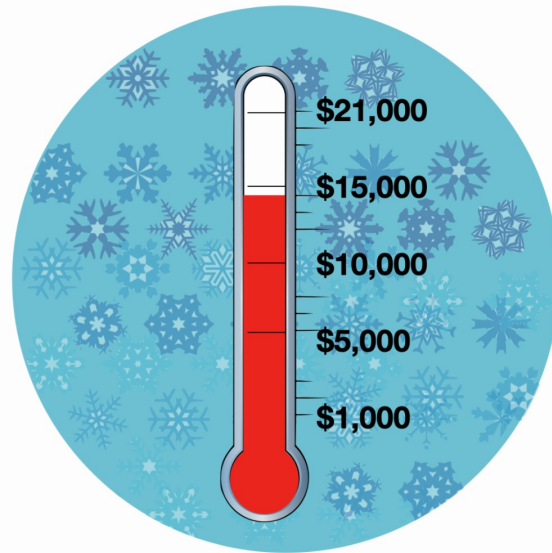
Dear Pine Hill Community,
