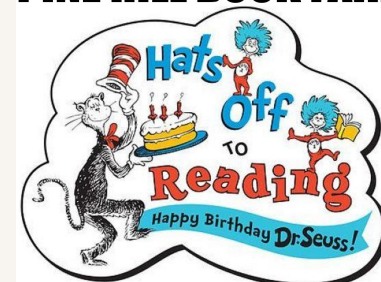

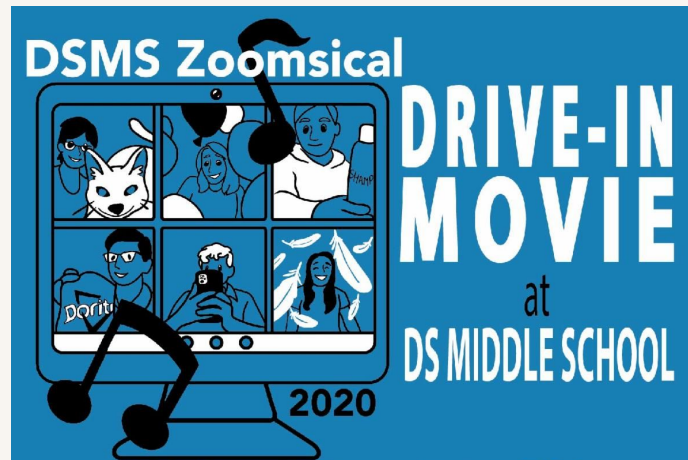
## Raffle Baskets
